7. Jubilee Year of Hope

• Background / Explanation suggest visit website Year of Jubilee 2025 - Catholic Bishops' Conference

• What's happening in the Diocese <u>The Jubilee Year 2025 | Birmingham Diocesan Trust</u>

• What s happening in the Parish?

Fr Oliver will address some of the themes during the Sunday Service

Diocesan programme of Visit of the doors of named churches. Possibly Chris D / Marina and Liaise to Fr O will look at developing a parish programme for the Jubilee year and getting people involved in leading different elements.

Six Themes we need to link into them and bring a programme together.

(Here are the six themes of the Jubilee Year, as established by the Catholic Church, generally revolve around key spiritual and communal pillars. Here they are:

- 1. Celebration: Marking 50 years with gratitude and festivity.
- 2. **Restoration**: Emphasizing forgiveness, reconciliation, and renewal.
- 3. Rebirth: Focused on spiritual revival and personal growth.
- 4. **Liberty**: Promoting justice, freedom, and peace.
- 5. **Solidarity**: Encouraging community building and support.
- 6. **Sabbath**: Emphasizing the importance of rest and reflection.

These themes aim to promote spiritual reflection, community unity, and a renewed commitment to faith and service.)

8. Parish Pilgrimages

Idea of a local pilgrimage – linked to the Jubilee year. Possibly an ecumenical vespers as All saints in Burton Dassett to link Jubilee year Ecumenism and the 1700 aniversary of the Nicene Creed. Fr Oliver to float the idea at the Churches Together meeting on 29 Jan Medjugorje still raising funds – plans going ahead. Deanery – pilgrimage to Littlemore – in March TBC

9. What does it mean to be a Benedictine parish?

Hoping to start morning prayer ⁻ possibly starting during LENT Corner ⁻ of Old Confessional ⁻ to be used to celebrate Benedictine Life Cluster meeting ⁻ Saturdays in Lent for talks by Fr Oliver possibly 15/22/29 March & April TBC

10. Use it or Lose it our liturgy practices

Two readers for Sunday Mass approved. Fr Oliver to intone the Alleluia at Mass Discussion on how to support the parishes continual liturgical development. Idea of a brief hymn practice/ liturgical CPD before each of the Masses (in place of the music that FR A used to play) to help everyone keep in touch with Catholic traditions like the singing of the Salve Regina or the Sanctus / Agnus Dei / Credo

11. Any Other Business

Fr Oliver proposed a name change for this committee: **Liturgy and Formation Committee** to distinguish it from the other group which also uses the word Faith. AGREED by all.
